

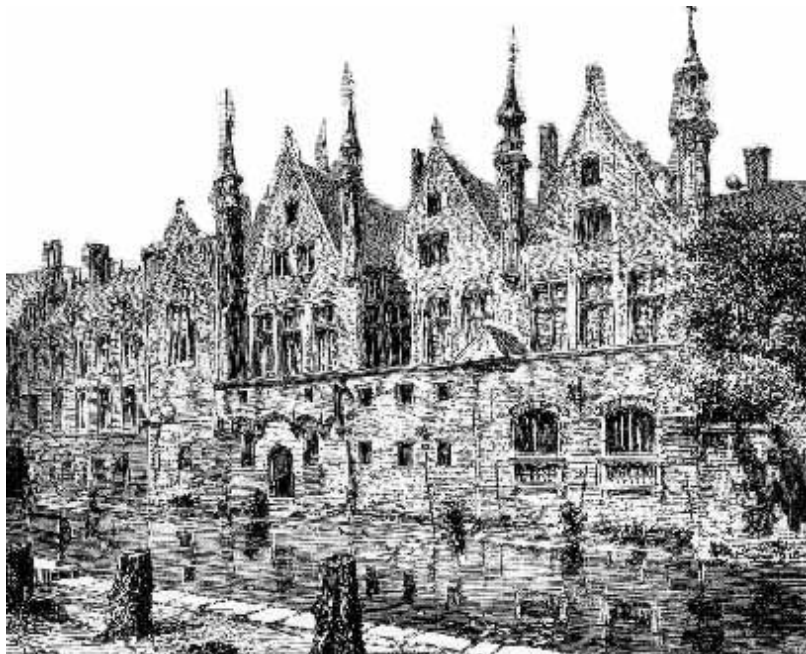

Highlights include:

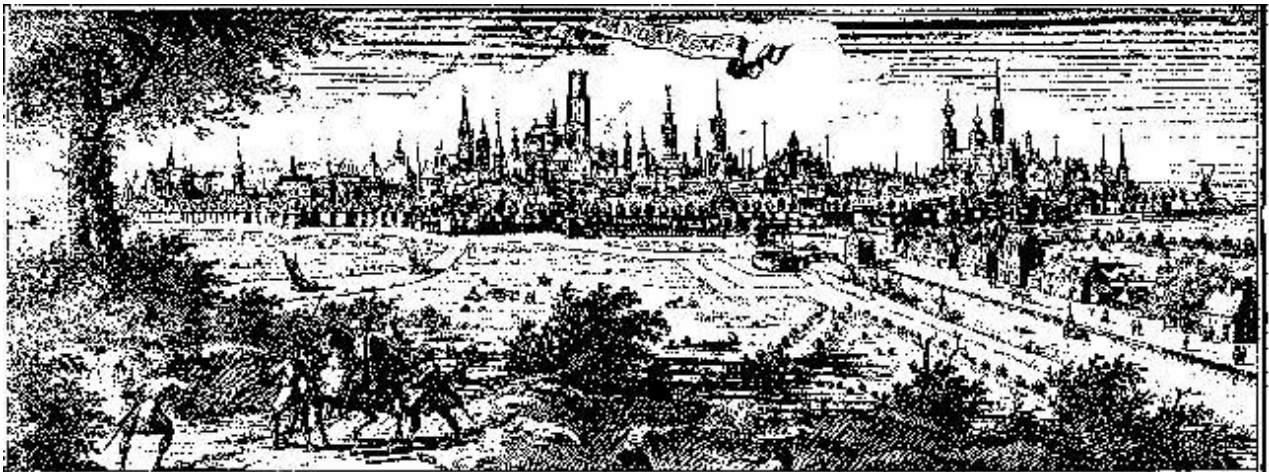
