

ROOPKUND TREK



Situated at an elevation of about 5000m in the lap of the Trishul Massif, the lake is famous for the mystery surrounding it. Skeletal remains of human beings who probably died about 600 years ago are found in the lake. The journey is fascinating as you come across the largest cypress trees ever seen, beautiful Himalayan villages, meadows and snow views.

Duration: 10/12 days

Season: May to November

Minimum 4 pax

Day 1 Leave Delhi for Kathgodam on an overnight train.

Day 2 Kathgodam to Ranikhet by car. Overnight stay at Holm farm

Day 3 Ranikhet to Debal by jeep

Day 4 Debal to Mandoli by jeep and then to Wan trekking

Day 5 Wan to Bedni Bugyal – trek

Day 6 Bedni Bugyal to Baggu Basa – trek

Day 7 Baggu Basa to Roop Kund to Bedni Bugyal – trek

Day 8 Bedni Bugyal to Wan – trek

Day 9 wan to Gwaldam by jeep. Overnight stay at the TRC

Day 10 Gwaldam to Nainital /Naukuchiya Tal by car. Overnight stay at Claridges/Lake Resort

Day 11 Nainital / Naukuchiya Tal to Kathgodam by car. Overnight train to Delhi

Day 12 Delhi
