



Bhutan Beautiful Gasa Hot Spring Trek

Paro-Thimpu-Tashithang - Geon Damji - Gasa Hot Spring - Geon -Damji -Tashigtang - Zomlingthang - Thimpu - Paro

Itinerary

Day 1. Arrive at Paro airport and transfer to the hotel.

Day 2. Paro – Thimpu. Follow the winding road beside Pa Chu down stream to its confluence with the river Wangchu River then up the valley to Thimpu. Afternoon visit at the Memorial Chorten, rest of the time at leisure.

Day 3. Drive from Thimpu to Tashithang, which should take about 4 hours. On the way visit Wangdi Dzong and lunch in Wangdi guesthouse. After lunch visit Punakha Dzong and continue to drive to Tashithang. Overnight in camp.

Day 4. Tashithang – Geon Damji. Trek through high agricultural benches above the Mo Chu into a lush semi-tropical gorge filled with banana trees and occasional monkeys. Overnight in camp. Altitude is 2280 metres. Distance 17Km.

Day 5. Geon Damji – Gasa Hot Spring. Trek through rolling hillsides with vistas of fields, villages and oak trees and pine forests. Gasa Dzong will be visible. Overnight in camp. Altitude is 2350 metres. Distance 21Km.

Day 6. Gasa Hot Spring . After a late breakfast, relax in the hot spring or stroll around in the Gasa village. Overnight in camp.

Day 7. Gasa Hot Spring – Geon Damji. After a climb away from the Gasa hot spring, the trail winds through rolling hillsides with vistas, fields, villages, oak and pine trees. Distance 21Km. Overnight in camp.

Day 8. Geon Damji - Tashithang – Zomlingthang. The trail descends from the high agricultural benches above the river into a semi-tropical gorge filled with banana trees, creepers and the occasional monkey. Short drive to Zomlingthang from Tashithang. Overnight in camp.

Day 9. Zomlingthang – Thimpu. Drive to Thimpu, which takes about 4 hours. Enroute you cross the Docula Pass. From the pass if the weather is clear, there will be spectacular views of the snow-capped mountains. Rest at Docula café for tea and snacks. Continue drive to Thimpu for lunch. Afternoon to be spent sightseeing and shopping. Overnight at hotel.

Day 10. Early breakfast and drive to Paro airport to catch your onward departure flight.
